He is not here, but is risen.

LUKE 24:6

A student in Zion's Weekday Ministries program shared a little rhyme with me: "April showers bring May's flowers." We talked about the rhyme because we were talking about spring. The conversation got my mind thinking about flowers—the beauty and aroma of different flowers. Soon, the flowers will pop out of the ground, and the church will be filled with the scent of Easter flowers. I wonder how the women felt as they took the spices

to Jesus's tomb. Did the aromas bother their sinuses? Was their grief so great that they didn't even focus on the aromas? We may never know until we can ask them when we gather together in heaven because when they came near the tomb, they forgot about the aromas and focused on the empty tomb. The empty tomb is a sign of God's great power. Death lost its power

because Jesus conquered it. Death has no sting because God's love for us is so much greater. God desires to be in a relationship with us that death cannot hinder or stop. He continually calls us, just like Adam and Eve in the garden, to meet with Him and share what is happening in our lives, the good and the bad. The empty tomb shows that death cannot stop our conversation or life with God. Praise be to God!

We have daily opportunities to share with God what is going on in our lives and to hear God's encouragement, challenges, and corrections. This Easter, we have opportunities to invite others to develop their relationship with Jesus by inviting them to worship with us and walking with them through difficult moments, which opens the door for us to be Jesus' hands and feet. We can help our students through the Easter offering, which is split

between the Ethel

Westerman Moritz Scholarship fund, Camp Allegheny, Jumonville, and Wesley Woods. The three camps open doors for students to deepen their faith through a week-long event where they meet Jesus through worship, Bible study, and activities. The scholarship removes some financial burden to help our students focus on learning and deepening their faith.

May this Easter be filled with a deep understanding of God's love for you and His desire to be in a relationship with you!

Have you ever known someone who is incredibly lucky? They seemingly do well in everything they attempt. They never seem to struggle with any task they take on and they get along with everyone they have to associate with. Do you know someone like that? If you do, do you love them? Or do you hate them? (Now be honest). If you resent them to one degree or the other, is it because you firmly place yourself on the other side of the fence. Nothing comes easy for you and even the little tasks seem to take you way more time and effort to complete. I'm here to tell you however, that when everything is turning up roses, it is not necessarily a good thing for you or that person you know. Think about it this way, as the winter turns to spring, we are enjoying warmer weather, and the days are getting longer. The sun is bright and invites us to go outside and bask in its warmth. Soon summer will be just around the corner and those sunny summer days are absolutely marvelous! But here's the rub. All sunshine all the time sounds wonderful, but there needs to be a balance. Without rain and cloudy weather, there is no plant growth.

Eventually crops will wither and die without moisture. The landscape dries out and there becomes a danger of drought and potential forest fires. Remember last fall in California? Sunshine all the time created conditions that allowed fires to ignite and spread extremely fast. Nature needs to strike a balance between the sun and the rain. Between the good and the bad.

And as Christians we need to strike the balance as well.



We may think that all we need is the good things in life (i.e. – that sunny weather). But in reality, we need to experience the bumps in the road, the uphill climbs, the long stretches of hardship to develop us into the kind of people God wants us to be. Just as a metallurgist refines gold by using fire, God refines us by using the hardships and trials we face in our lives. These trials then mold us into the type of Christians the Lord wants us to be. Without those trials we are just raw, undeveloped elements, ill-equipped to handle rough times in the future. We may not realize it as it is happening, but we are strengthened by the hardships we face. They actually improve us. Shape us into better people. Better Christians.

We are currently moving through the season of Lent. In several weeks we will be celebrating Easter, and that is a wonderful time in the church calendar. I encourage you to use this remaining time in Lent to look at the rough items in your life. The looming rainstorms. The darkness, the “evil”. Then I encourage you to

look at those elements and how you can tackle them and use them to strengthen you as a Christian.

Reflect on those tough times and take stock in how the Lord is using them as a fire to refine your soul.

Perhaps you gave up something for Lent, or perhaps you made a Lenten commitment to do something outside your comfort zone to assist you friends and neighbors. Use that commitment to stoke the fire and refine you as a loved child of God. And if you didn't make a commitment on Ash Wednesday, it's not too late. Be on the lookout for ways to become closer to the Lord as Easter approaches. And when you see

them, take action. Pray that God will use the rain in your live to water

and strengthen you!**Happy Easter!**

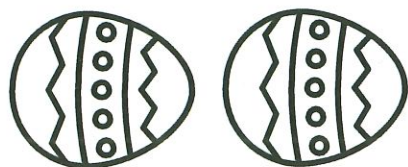

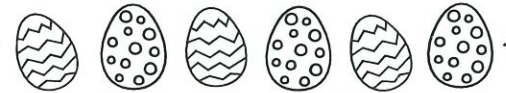

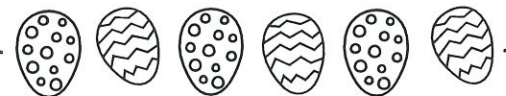

Family Promise House

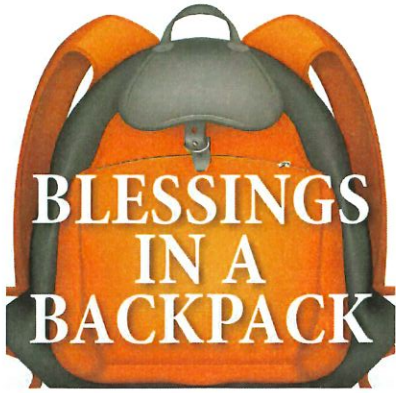
For the month of **April**, Zion is collecting cleaning items for Family Promise House. **April's**

BLESSINGS IN A BACKPACK



Only a few months remain in the 2024-2025 year and the Blessings in a Backpack program continues to be a vital service offering weekend meals to local students. Although this is a nationally funded program, its success relies on the commitment and generosity of those locally who are willing to financially support this effort. Zion continues to play an important role in this success!!

On February 14, Zion provided another **five weeks** of food items at a cost of **\$1,193.26**. So far in this school year, your contribution of **\$5,071.90** has supplied enough food to fill **65 packs** per week for **21 weeks!** That is **1,365 packs of weekend meals!** Thank you so very much!!

The amount of food recently purchased will adequately satisfy the need through March. Approximately, an additional eight weeks of meals will be needed to finish out the school year. Unfortunately, Zion's fund designated for Blessings has been exhausted! The average cost to fill 65 packs per week is about \$250. This means that, roughly, \$2,000 will be needed to complete the year. Would you please consider making a financial donation so Zion can continue to provide nourishment to those who have come to depend on this service? If you wish to contribute, please mark offering envelope "Blessings in a Backpack." Each dollar is greatly appreciated as are your thoughts and prayers for this program and the families it serves. 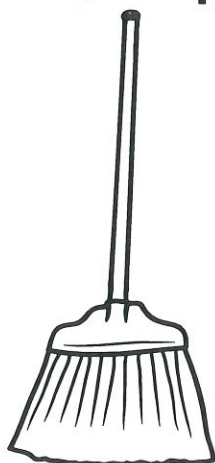

EASY ICED PEACH AND CINNAMON ROLL BUNDT CAKE



Ingredients:

- 2 Pillsbury Grand Cinnamon Rolls/icing
- 2 Cans Sliced Peaches
- 1/2 Cup Brown Sugar Packed
- Cinnamon
- Pam spray

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Grease bundt pan with pam spray. Drain your peaches and pour into your bundt pan. Sprinkle cinnamon lightly on top of peaches and then, sprinkle brown sugar onto the peaches. Open your cinnamon roll setting the icing aside for later. Cut cinnamon rolls into 4 pieces into your Bundt pan. Place in 350degree oven for 35 to 45 minutes until golden brown.

Let set for 10 to 15 minutes to cool then place serving dish over your bundt and flip the cake onto the dish will be messy so make sure your dish is a bit bigger than you bundt.

Take your icing you set aside and place in microwave for 10 seconds and drizzle over your cake and serve when you are ready.

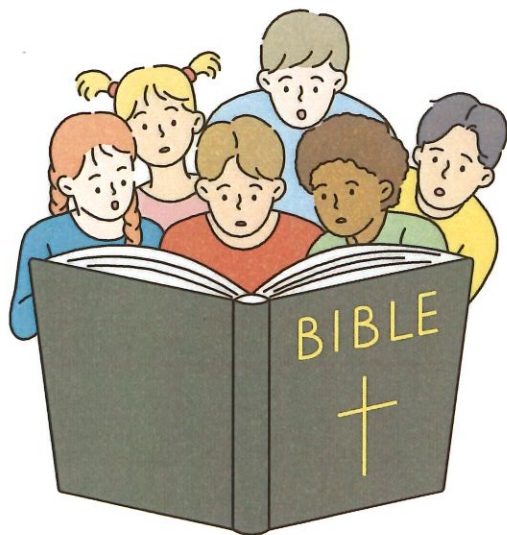

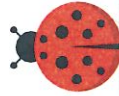
