Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. ⁷ Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil. ⁸ This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

~ Proverbs 3:5-8

Wise sayings have a way of getting us not only to think differently, but also to act differently. We think differently because the wise sayings cause us to think about them, not because they are difficult to understand, but because they are layered in meaning. Proverbs 3:5 is a good example. It says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." It is simple: Trust in the Lord with all your heart. There is nothing complex about it until you start looking into what it means to trust in the Lord with all your heart. Trusting God with my whole heart means that I give Him everything in my heart, like my fears, pains, struggles, temptations, joys, excitement, stress, and the list goes on. All does mean all or everything. There is nothing that should not be entrusted to the Lord. It is simple yet profound. We have a hard time trusting the Lord with everything in our hearts. We want to hold on to the bad things because they make us look bad in God's eyes, but the truth is, He already knows. He already knows what is in our hearts, but wants to hear it from us. It is hard for us to admit that we don't share everything with God or trust Him with all that is within us.

What happens if we do trust Him? Proverbs 3:6 says, "He will make your paths straight." What does it mean that our paths will be straight? Straight paths are the most direct and safest paths to take. Your journey is shorter, and you can see the dangers lurking there because nothing is hidden or around a bend. It doesn't mean that the paths are easy. It means you can see what is coming and will be prepared for it because God is there with you.

Our lives are filled with twists and turns. We often find ourselves feeling alone and abandoned. Most times, it is because we try to live through our strength instead of trusting God and leaning on Him. What does it look like to lean on Him? We pray and ask God to handle the twists. We share our concerns with others and allow them to pray for us. We read the Bible to find out what God wants us to do during difficult times. We listen to the words of those further along the spiritual journey than we are. Their words of experience may be hard to hear, but most often point us in the direction we should be going. The promise is that God will direct our path. It might not go where we want, but we can trust God to take us where He wants. Take the time to trust God with all your heart. You will be better off.
