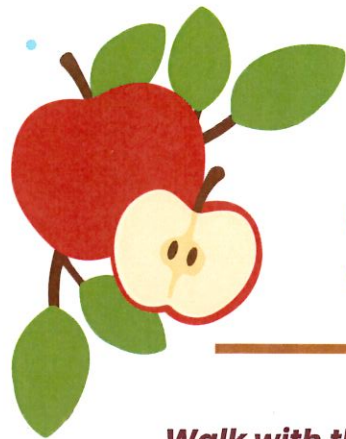

PASTOR TO PARSONS

Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm.

~ Proverbs 13:20

Who is the wisest person alive that you have a personal relationship with? Is it a family member? A friend? A mentor? When I am struggling with a decision, my go-to person varies depending on the situation. Over the years, I have cultivated many friendships with wise people. Most of the time, I have been guided to make good decisions, and every once in a while, I have been steered wrong or ignored their wisdom, which didn't lead to the best of places.

Proverbs 13:20 is one proverb among many proverbs that stand alone in this section of Proverbs. Each of these proverbs offers solid advice, but I wanted to focus on verse 20, especially as young people head back to school. We should walk with wisdom and become wise. Wise people are those who understand the situation and can guide themselves and others through difficult times. Wise people are those who share their experiences to help those around them, not in a condescending way but in a way that builds others up. Wise people may not be the most intelligent people in the room, but they can put what they have learned into practice. It may not be easy to spot wise people because they usually don't step forward at first, but they will if directly asked. Is there someone coming to your mind?

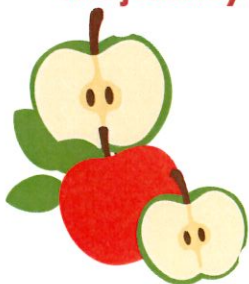
If no one comes to mind, spend the next 31 days reading through each chapter of Proverbs. In each chapter, you will find at least one proverb that will make a difference. The hard part is not finding the proverb but putting it into practice. It is one thing to know it and quote it. It is a totally different commitment to put it into practice, but we need to do so. Another step beyond that is to find someone who will walk with you until you have mastered it.

It is easier to walk with people who are alive and with whom we have a personal relationship than to read a proverb and try to enact it on our own. It is not impossible, but it does take more time and effort. It takes time to understand what the proverb means and to see the circumstances in which it applies to our lives. It takes time to develop the courage to admit our mistakes and the discipline to live out the proverbs, especially when no one is walking with us.

The journey of wisdom is not an easy road, but it is worth it.

Pat Gray will be 100 years old on September 14!

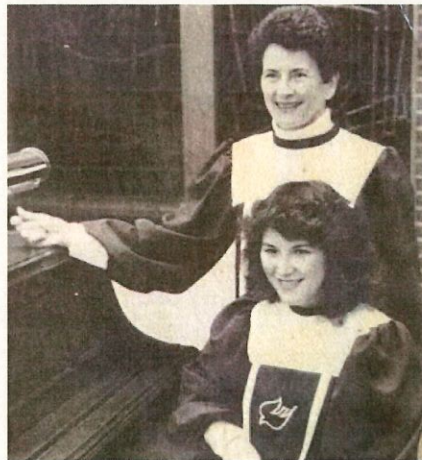
We are planning to celebrate on

ZION'S RECIPE



Zucchini Bake

Ingredients:

1 Large Zucchini
 1/4 cup chopped onion
 1 Can Cream of Chicken Soup

Recipe by Shannon Kooser

1 Cup Sour Cream
 1 stick Butter (melted)
 1 6 oz pkg Stove Top Stuffing Mix

Cut Zucchini into 1/2 in slices, then cut into fourths. Add to boiling water for 5 minutes. Drain well. Sauté onions in a bit of butter. Combine zucchini, onions, sour cream, and soup. Mix melted butter and stuffing mix. Put 1/2 of the mixture on the bottom of a 9X13 dish. Then add the zucchini mixture, then the rest of the stuffing mix on top.

Bake for 30-45 minutes at 350 degrees.

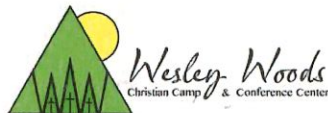

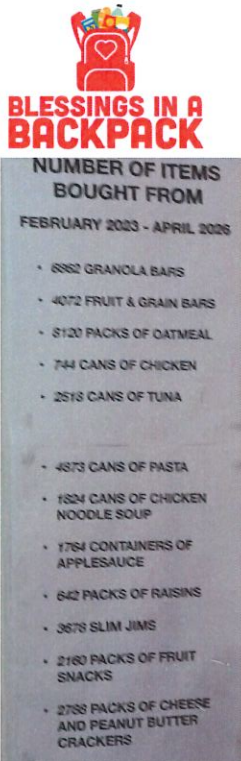

Building Fund—This fund is for the Faith We Build Campaign, which pays the mortgage for the Family Life Center.

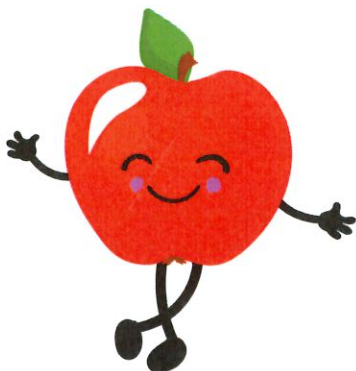

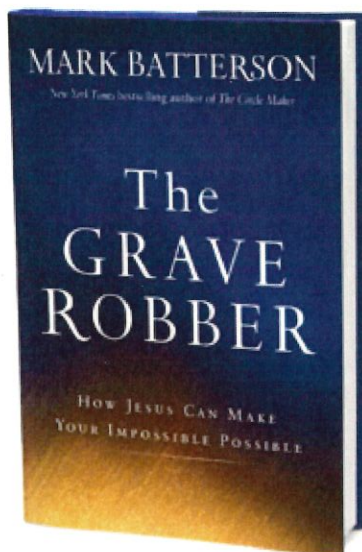

- 1 TSSP vanilla

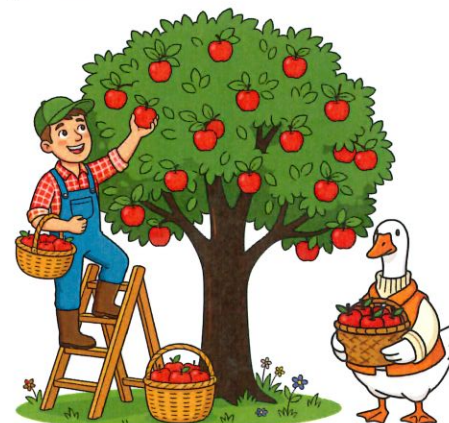
Place all ingredients in the crock pot. Then blend all ingredients with a whisk.

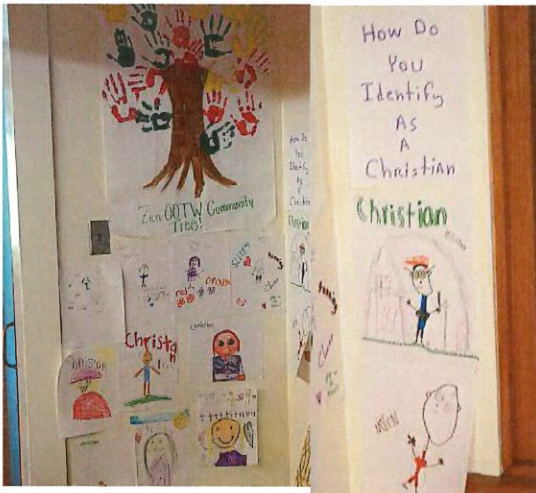
